Sodium chloride is universally used as a food additive. It is also used in the production of paper and pulp, in bathroom products and in detergents. In oil and gas exploration, salt is an important component of drilling fluids in well drilling. In textiles and dry cleaning, salt is used as a brine rinse to separate organic contaminants. It is also used in the processing of aluminum, beryllium, copper, steel and vanadium. In the paper and pulp industry, salt is used to bleach wood pulp.
